SEEDLING TREE PROGRAM 2010

Dear Cooperator:

Enclosed are the order forms for the 2010 Seedling Tree Program, Fertilizer Tablets, Seedling Protectors, Polymer, Weed Barrier and Drip Irrigation Supplies. Larger tree guards, 6 inch dia. X 30 inch or 48 inch can be ordered. Call for quote.

Please review the Conditions of Sale; complete the requested information on acres of planting, type of planting, location, name, address and phone number; and SIGN the application. Orders due APRIL 8, 2010 but, order NOW before some species are sold out.

Bareroot Stock is available in multiples of 50 per species at a cost of \$4200 per 50 seedlings for deciduous trees and shrubs. Potted stock is available in multiples of 30 per species with a minimum order of 30 for \$52.50. Small container stock is available at \$32.00 per box of 30. For replacement trees on established windbreaks you may order trees singly -- Potted \$2.75 each and bareroot \$1.50 each. I do have a few larger 1 & 2 gallon potted trees at \$10.00 each plus \$2. deposit on pot or trade pots. Please call on availability. Sales tax of 2.9% must be included in your payment. Sales tax is figured on your total. If the seedlings or a portion of your order is sold out, we will refund the cost of the seedlings unless you request a substitution.

Payment must accompany order. Checks are made payable to COLORADO STATE FOREST SERVICE. If you order any combination of seedlings, fertilizer tablets, tree protectors, shades or polymer, you may make payment for all items on one check. The seedlings, fertilizer tablets, etc. will be delivered to our office in April. I will advise you several days in advance when and where the trees may be picked up. .

In order to successfully establish trees to meet your needs you must put some thought and effort into your planning. You must consider your objectives, available space, location, soil types, site preparation, species, how to plant, fertilizer needs, cultivation, watering and protection. I would be happy to assist you.

We will be offering tree planting, watering, or full windbreak or shelterbelt care again this year on limited basis depending upon hiring freeze. Please contact us for availability if you desire these services.
