I'm posting these photos of the fire water trailer

I built just as food for thought. I'm not suggesting

that everyone living on the Ranch should become

a self-styled firefighter. That should be left up to

our fire fighting volunteers.

There are certain situations, however, when I feel

it's possible to extinguish a fire before it gets too

large to handle, and that's what this trailer is for.

The tank holds 450 gallons. The 3" trash pump came

from Northern Tool, the 1" and 1 1/2" hoses are

from eBay, as are the nozzles. It's plumbed so that

either the garden hose or the fire hoses can be used.

If anyone is interested in building their own unit,

I'd be happy to share my experience.
