 - Para 3.3: Add e-mail as an acceptable method of contacting/notifying property owners.
 Closed after discussion withdrawn
 - Para 5.1.2.1: Rental Agreements submitted to the Association: Added submitted the Association's "Secretary". Closed
 - Para 5.6: County guidance on temporary residence time limitations: Closed
 - o Para 5.7: Add sanitation services: Closed
 - o Para 8.6: Rename to "Financials" or something equivalent. Closed
 - o Para 8.6.1: Relocate Board information to separate para. **Closed**
 - Add statement that Owners are ultimately responsible for their actions and the actions of their visiting family, guests, and contractors. Closed
 - Add a statement that owners must ensure that during the building process they ensure adequate trash removal, sanitation services, and building permit is located on site.

 - Add a section covering the "construction process" Closed
 - o Address Guest Parking Restrictions: Closed
 - Address Storage containers, antennas, and windmills: Closed
 - Clarify number of residences allowed per lot, Follow County guidelines: Closed

The Committee agreed to submit our recommendations to the Board by the end of May allowing them time to review/approve or return to committee for further action prior to 4 June Board Meeting. It is the intent to submit a proposed Ballot Measures document to the Board along with the proposed Declaration. We will also offer the Board June 1, 2, or 3 as dates for the Committee to brief the Board in-person if they so choose.
